Privacy Policy

On the 25th May 2018, the new General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) took effect. As we (the league) hold data relating to you, we are legally obliged to inform you of the personal data we hold for you and how we will use it.

We request you read the information below and if you object to the data we hold or how it is processed, then please contact us directly and we will remove the information.

Information about you

We hold your information within our systems, this information includes:

Your Name

Your Address

Various telephone numbers as supplied by yourself

Various e-mail addresses as supplied by yourself

How we use this information

We use this information for the purposes of managing your contract (team entry) with the league. To achieve this, some of your information will be shared with Badminton England, the respective club secretaries for teams in the league & league officials. To run emails your email address will be stored in the contacts list of email providers such as Google.

For those clubs entering the normal league, contact details will be added to the BDBL website as part of the club directory, to allow other clubs to contact you as well as prospective members.

This information will never be deliberately shared with any person or company other than those mentioned above.

Whenever we collect or process your personal data, we will only keep it for as long as is necessary for the purpose for which it was collected. At the end of this period, your data will either be deleted completely or anonymised.

What are your rights over your personal data?

You have the right to request:

- Access to the personal data we hold about you, free of charge
- The correction of your personal data when incorrect, out of date or incomplete.
- That we stop any consent-based processing of your personal data after you withdraw that consent.
- That you be "forgotten" or have your data erased, in certain situations.

You can contact us to request to exercise these rights at any time as follows by email or letter to the league secretary or results secretary,

Your right to withdraw consent

Whenever you have given us your consent to use your personal data, you have the right to change your mind at any time and withdraw that consent.
